

PROCLAMATION FOR COLON CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, colon cancer is the second leading cause of cancer related deaths in men and women in the United States; and

WHEREAS, colon cancer is one of the few cancers that can be prevented with timely screening, but one in three eligible Americans are not up-to-date on screening; and

WHEREAS, a colonoscopy is a procedure that detects small growths or polyps so they can be removed before they develop into cancer; and screening finds colon cancer early when treatment can be most effective; and

WHEREAS, screening for colon cancer should begin at age 45, or younger if at high risk, and continue at regular intervals recommended by health care providers.


WHEREAS, Observing Colon Cancer Awareness Month provides a special opportunity to increase awareness and offer education on the importance of early detection and screening of colon cancer.
