PUBLIC COMMENT

Residents who would like to make public comment can log on to Free Conference Call during the meeting or can e-mail the Township Clerk (gheber@westwindsortwp.com) by no later than 11:00 a.m. on the day of the Council meeting. These emails will be read into the public record during the public comment period of the meeting.

Ms. Judi Strober, 5 Quail Ridge, noted she would like the Township to pursue sewer line installation in her development.

Mr. Irving Zatz, 8 Huntington Drive, would like the Township to conduct a survey in his development regarding installation of a sewer line.

Mr. William Rutledge, 17 Scott Avenue, noted his concerns with traffic along Alexander Road and the need for the roadway to be repaved after the installation of new waterlines by New Jersey American Water earlier this year. He advised that a petition signed by 75 of his neighbors was delivered to the Township requesting additional pedestrian crossing safety improvements throughout this area.

Mayor Marathe addressed Mr. Rutledge's concerns and reported that the roadway should be repaved within the next two weeks. He advised that the Traffic Sergeant was out observing traffic and that there are less cars daily now than pre-covid. Mayor Marathe noted that both Ms. Mandel and Mr. Stevens have also been out in this area observing traffic and hearing resident concerns.

Ms. Lisa Wolfe, 1 Partridge Run, requested that a sewer survey be conducted in her development as well.

Ms. Huber read twenty-nine name and addresses into the record which will be attached to the minutes advising they are all interested in having a sewer survey conducted to see what the expense will be for installation of a sewer system in their area.

Mayor Marathe addressed the questions from residents inquiring about the installation of sewer lines in their developments. He

advised that he would speak to his staff and advise residents of the next step.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS

Ms. Schmid made the following announcements:

- Mercer County Libraries to open on October 5th
- Municipal Offices will be closed in observance of Columbus Day on Monday, October 12th
- Update of Flu Clinics 10/6, 10/14, 10/20, and 10/22

Mayor Marathe advised everyone that the mail-in ballots should be arriving in the mail soon and that the Township has a mail-in ballot box located out front of the West Windsor Senior Center. He also announced that at the West Windsor Farmers Market this Saturday, October 3rd will be the 3rd Annual Electric Vehicle Day. Mayor Marathe also noted that there will be a re-useable bag give away at the Farmers Market sponsored by the West Windsor Environmental Commission.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Stevens advised that he participated in the Flu Clinic today and thanked all who showed up and noted it was very organized.

Ms. Gawas encouraged everyone to get their flu shot this year. She reminded residents that pedestrian and bicyclists should wear reflective clothing to ensure drivers can see them.

Ms. Geevers advised that Administration is working on the Alexander Road issues. She noted that there is a set process for developments to get sewer lines installed and that the Township has to follow that process. She encouraged everyone to use the Vote By Mail-in Ballot box located at the West Windsor Senior Center. Ms. Geevers announced that electric car charging stations have been installed at Nassau Park and that the 2020 Census has been extended till the end of September she encouraged all residents to fill it out.

Mr. Hersh encouraged everyone to get their flu shots this year. He encouraged everyone to attend the Electric Car Show this Saturday at the West Windsor Farmers Market. Mr. Hersh thanked

all the other candidates for applying and thanked Council for selecting him.

CHAIR/CLERK COMMENTS

President Mandel reminded everyone the importance of filling out the 2020 Census. She reminded everyone to watch for bicyclists making right-hand turns. President Mandel encouraged everyone to attend the Electric Car Show this weekend being held at the West Windsor Farmers Market. She thanked Ms. Manzari for preparing her to take on the role of President while she was Vice President.

Tonight, a new member of Council was chosen by a poll of just four individuals on Council, instead of the nearly 20,000 voters of West Windsor. Council members Geevers, Stevens, and Mandel should answer the questions put to them twelve days ago, on September 17, as to whether they knew of the outgoing member's plans in late July to leave town, and if so, whether they acted to encourage the seven-week delay until a resignation was announced in mid-September. This delay has needlessly and unfairly prevented us voters from choosing, in a free and fair election, the replacement who will represent us.

If all has gone as expected, Council members Geevers, Stevens, and Mandel participated in the majority vote to appoint Andrew Hersh, that's H-E-R-S-H, Hersh, to fill the vacant seat. It will help to maximize the legitimacy of Council Member Hersh's one year of service on the Council if voters knew that the three members who appointed him to his seat had no hand in their being the method of his selection.
