3. Bob Hillier advised that his staff has addressed all inquiries by phone, or in person regarding the project.
4. President Geevers requested additional information be developed regarding the redevelopment area's current zoning versus changing the zoning
5. Mayor/Hillier staff will prepare a fact sheet of pro's and con's of redevelopment area ten most frequently asked questions
6. Ms. Kleinman requested discussion of the reports submitted by Hillier to Council at a public meeting.
7. Mayor advised that Township staff and professionals will review the reports and give a report to Council
8. Mayor prepare to hold a Town Hall Meeting between June and August regarding the redevelopment project
